As we wrap up the financial year 2023-24, we are filled with immense pride and satisfaction. This year holds special significance as it marks the 'Silver Jubilee' of WE CARE, a major milestone in our organization's history. Reflecting on our journey, we celebrate the numerous advancements we've achieved over the years. Initiated with a noble vision, WE CARE has thrived embracing diverse strategies, allowing us to push boundaries and dream bigger with the support of dedicated individuals and groups.

We are deeply grateful to our supporters, friends, benefactors, as well as our committed staff and beneficiaries, all of whom have played pivotal roles in our progress.

We are eager to provide you with an overview of the events and achievements of the past year.

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMME AND ACTIVITIES

We Care facilitates children's education through Scholarships and Free Evening Tuition Classes, adhering to meticulous procedures to ensure that economically disadvantaged and deserving students benefit. In the fiscal year 2023-24, a total of **Rs. 16,77,700.00** was allocated towards Scholarship support. This reached **896** students in **25 schools and hostels** located across various states of India.

Besides, **Rs. 36037.00** were spent on educational program for Free Evening Tuition class encompassed, provisions for nutrition, healthcare, uniforms, books, study materials, and teacher's salary, aiming to enhance learning opportunities comprehensively. The total amount spent was **Rs.17,13,737.00**

Some of the programmes conducted during the year:

Independence Day, Teachers Day, Environment Day, Karnataka Rajyostava Day, Children's Day, Deepavali, Year ending programme, Republic Day, Founder's Day, Silver Jubilee Celebration, Women's Day, Free Evening Tuition Closing, etc.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMME

We Care extended support to **38 dialysis and other patients** during 2023-24. With the help of CSR from Rambus Technologies Pvt. Ltd, Bangalore, **26 patients** received assistance, while **12 patients** were supported using, We Care's own funds. **Rs. 654.00** was spent for medicines for a poor person. The total amount spent was **Rs. 7,20,654.00.**

WOMEN AND CHILD PROGRAMME & ACTIVITIES

During the year 2023-24, a total of **Rs. 1,205** was spent on activities including International Women's Day celebration, education and mentoring of girl children, and counselling and support for women.

CARE OF SENIOR CITIZENS

We Care provided financial support for the palliative care of Senior Citizens at **Ave Maria Palliative Care** and **St Joseph Prashanth Nivas, Mangalore** in 2023-24. The total amount spent was **Rs. 24,000.00**, funded by the Mervyn and Irene Colaco Charity Fund. **Rs. 761.00** was provided for ration for a poor person.

OFFICE ACTIVITIES

In 2023-24, our office staff focused on several key areas: staff development (training), efficient record management, organizing events, financial management (accounting and correspondence), promoting our organization (publicity and public relations), ensuring regulatory compliance, and fundraising.
